2. Esau likes being outside; Jacob likes being close to home. What is your favorite thing to do outside? Inside?
3. What are some ways brothers and sisters can betray and hurt each other?
4. How do we forgive one another in our family?



### Live It

**For families to do together:** Play a game of follow the leader. Take turns being the leader of the family.

**For pre-k kids:** Have someone put a variety of objects in a paper bag. Reach into the bag without looking and see if you can guess each object as you touch it. As you play this game, remember Isaac trying to identify Esau.
