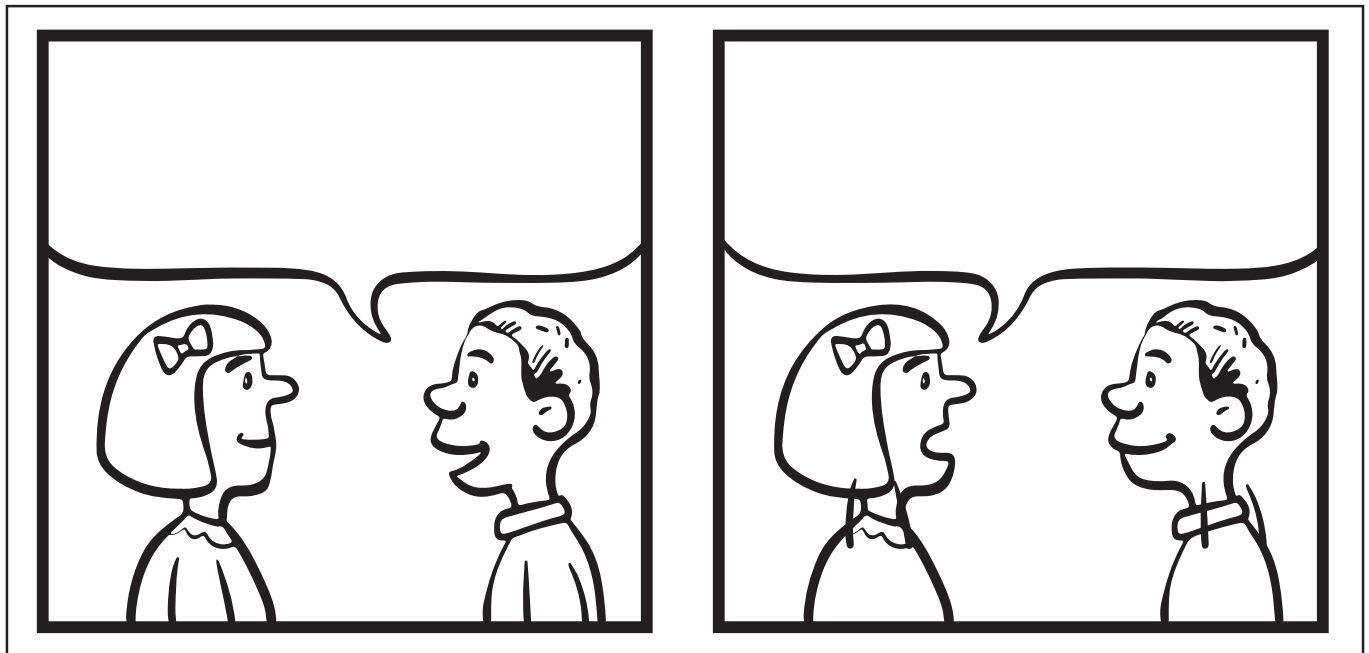
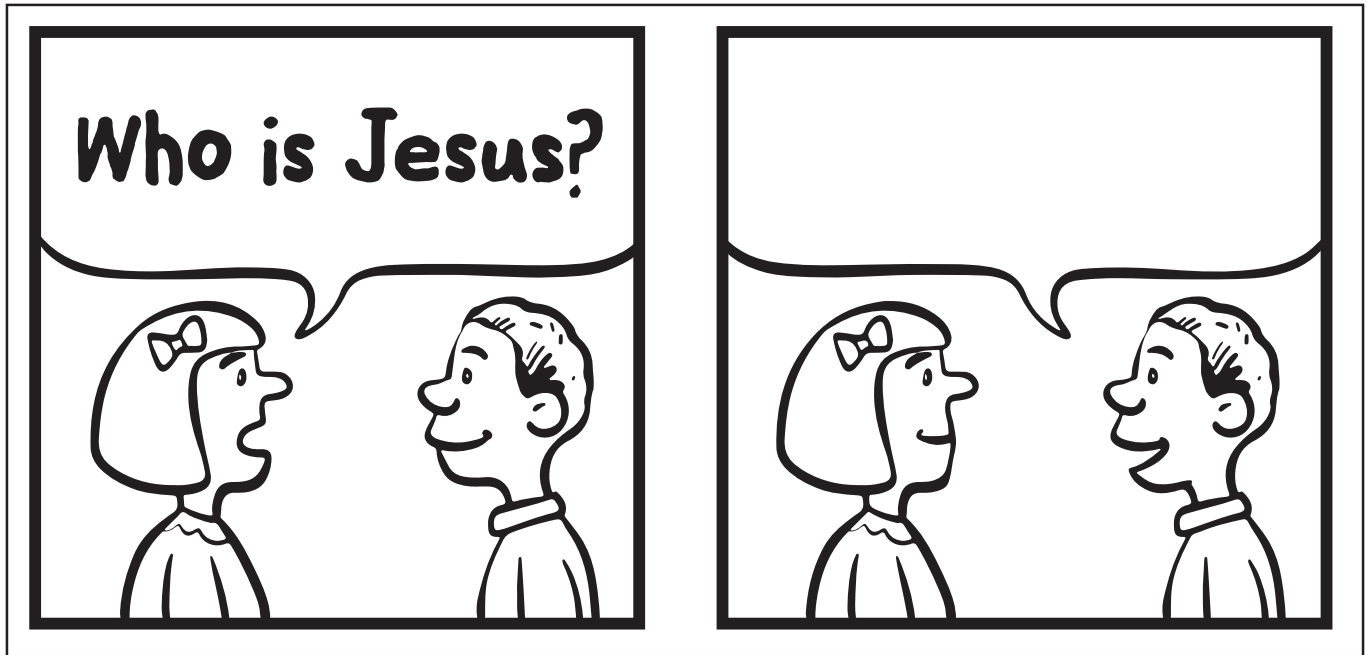
## Share Jesus
