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See It

4. Get a piece of paper. Together as a family, design a brand new animal. Take turns adding to a picture of what your new animal looks like. What is its name? Where does it live and how does it behave?



Live It

For families to do together: Bring gloves and a garbage bag along on a walk you take together. As you walk, pick up any litter you find along the way.

For pre-k kids: Decorate your sidewalk with chalk pictures of God's earth and people caring for it (or draw on paper with crayons and decorate your front window with your drawings)
