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**MORNING TIME**

Start each day by being honest with God about how you feel. If you don't know what to pray, start with something like this:

"God, thank you listening to my honest prayers. Right now, I need You to help me. I am worried/sad/angry about \_\_\_\_\_. Please give me courage/patience/peace to get through this."

Encourage your teen to join you in this challenge this month.

**THEIR TIME**

Encourage your teen to take 30 seconds every day this month to write down something God did for them in the past that can help them remember God's faithfulness in the future.

Help them get started by sharing a few examples from your own life.

**MEAL TIME**

At meals this month, share stories about times you have given or received the gift of grace.

**BED TIME**

Pray that both you and your teen will never become complacent or indifferent to all that Jesus has done - and continues to do - for us.

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
